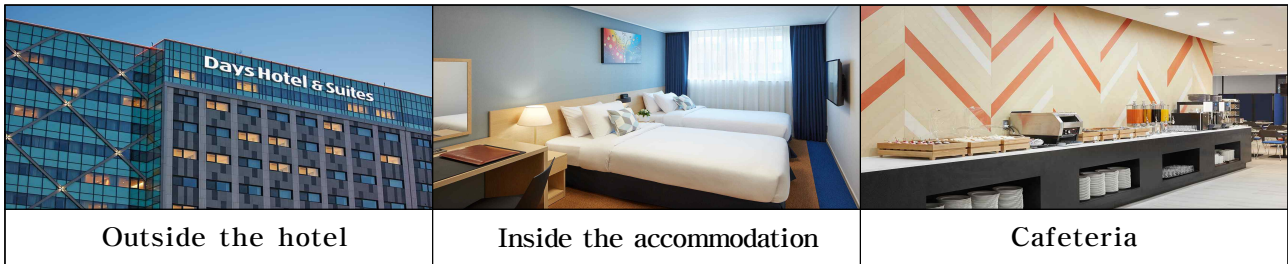

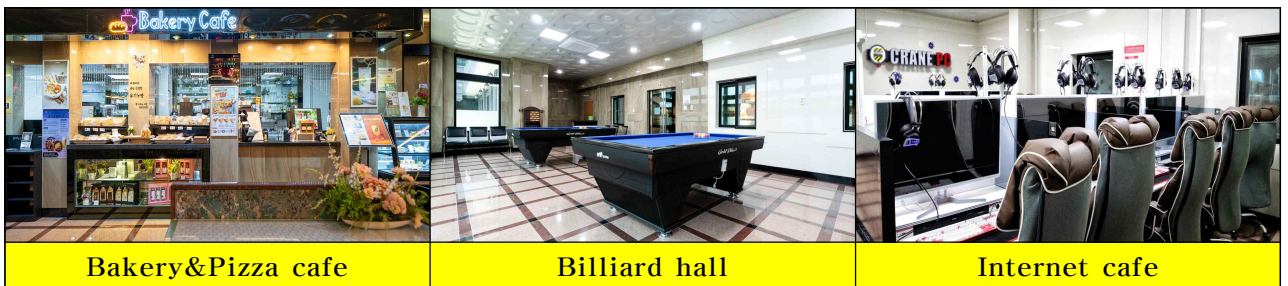
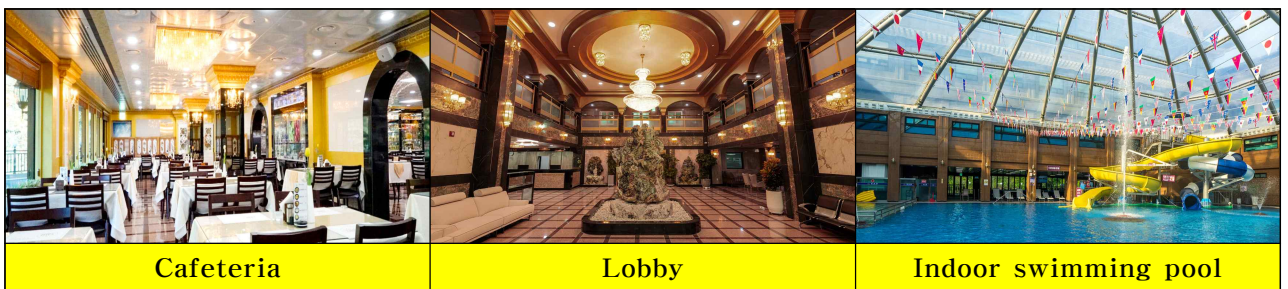

## 3. Requirements

- 1) One (1) representative player is allowed to participate from each country/territory.
- 2) Each Association is allowed to select the representative player according to their rules. Any Associations/Federations that hold the Korean Ambassador's Cup shall choose the winner of the competition as the representative player.
- 3) The representative player must have the nationality of the country he/she represents. However, if the participating country receives the approval of his/her different nationality from KBF in advance, it could be allowed.

## 4. Tournament Rules

- Tournament: **7 round Swiss System**
- Rule: All Even games, 6.5 points Dum(=Komi)
- Time limit: **20 minutes + Fischer time 20 seconds** increment per move  
*\*Player who exceed the time limit should lose 3points as a penalty, then another 20 seconds Fischer Time would be given only one time. (By the referee) If the player exceeds it again, it would be deemed to lose the match.*
- Tie break: WINS > SOS > SOSOS
- Notice: **Electronic devices would be prohibited** during the match.  
Please keep your phone silent or off. *(Paper review is allowed.)*
- Note
  - Timers and game recorders will be used for all games.
  - You should submit your phone to the headquarter or leave it on the desk when going to the bathroom.
  - Going to the bathroom with stopping the timer should be allowed only one time per a game.*\*If you have unavoidable issue such as disease, please contact the staff before the registration.*

*\*Please submit the flight ticket as the PDF format. If your country has no E-ticket service or any other specific reason, please contact the organizer before the registration.*

2) Participation fee for the guests

○ **Guest fee: 650,000KRW (≒500 USD) (cash only)**

- The guest fee should be given to the organizer at the registration desk and only cash would be available.

The fee would be used for giving same services as players during the 19th KPMC, and the additionally required costs would be borne by the host.

- The guest will share the room with his/her player or executive. If the guest needs own room, it should be told to the organizer in advance before the registration, which would require additional USD 250.

## 7. Accommodation&meals, and Flight

### 1) Accommodation & meals

- Meals and accommodation shown on the schedule would be provided by the KBF.

- According to the hotel condition, **two participants should share one twin-room**, so it is highly recommended to accompany a guest.

In case of accompanying two or more guests, a family room(room for 4 people) will be provided, and rooms for participants without any guest will be assigned by the host.

- Deluxe twin rooms, which have separate rooms, would be provided for representative players as possible for their maximum convenience.

*\*Upgraded rooms will be assigned in the order of ‘interviewees’, ‘players of mutual exchange country with KBF’, and quick registrations.*

- If you have any special dietary needs, you should write a **detailed**



**description** (*cf: No meat, but fish is available*) on the registration form.

Please notice the people would have own menu, not the menu for others. All responsibilities caused by no or incorrect information would lie with the people themselves.

## 2) Airfare support & requirements

- Eligible for support: Representative players and executives
- **Deadline: July 31** (Wed) \*KST
- Details: Please find the attached file, '**Flight guideline**'
- Note: All the eligible should submit the requirements to the host to get its approval before the deadline. In case of no or inappropriate document, the support would be not available. (**late submission impossible**)

## 8. Requests

### 1) Visa and Invitation

- If a player needs a Korean Visa, please check required documents with the Korean Embassy at first, and let us know if there is any document that needs to be prepared by the KBF when submitting the Visa application. The official invitation would require name of the invited, National Go Association the person belongs to, the address including his / her city, and postal (zip) code. If any problem occurs by wrong information, its responsibility would be to you.

Please notice that international delivery fee should be paid by you and **reducing the time required to issue visas is impossible**.

### 2) Dress code for ceremonies

- All players are recommended **not** to wear t-shirts, jeans or similar attire during the opening ceremonies and awards ceremonies.

### 3) Anti-doping test

- Randomly selected two of the top players must accept the anti-doping test.

#### 4) Emergency

- When any emergency occurs, please contact the organizers or interpreters whose contact numbers are written on the name tag.

#### 5) No misrepresentation & Stricter identification

- Associations in each country should thoroughly identify the participants and guarantee them, who should be qualified for the representative of your country. If participants of each country cause the following troubles that result in disorder during the timeframe, KBF may hold their associations responsible for it or further invitation may be restricted or revoked.

##### <Example of trouble>

- (1) Doing illegal acts (violence, sex crime, theft, etc.)
- (2) Staying in Korea illegally without returning to home country
- (3) Refusing to comply with the legitimate instructions of the competition manager  
(*cf: constant lateness for the meeting time, disobedient with the proper judgment by the referee, etc.*)
- (4) Any other acts to undermine the dignity of the representative of each country significantly

#### 6) Mandatory Announcement for early leave

- Participants can act individually without returning to Incheon after the closing ceremony. In this case, KBF must be notified of the fact that you would not return and the scheduled date of return **by September 5** (15 days before the start of the KPMC). If it is not announced in advance, the support afterwards will be limited to cover unnecessary additional costs, so please be aware of it.
