

3. Requirements

- 1) One national representative player and one U15 youth representative player are allowed to participate from each country/territory.
 - U15 youth player should be born in 2010 or later. (No matter with the birth date and month, but only the year)
- 2) Each Association is allowed to select the representative players according to their rules. Associations and Federations that hold the Korean Ambassador's Cup are recommended to choose the winner of the competition as the representative player.
- 3) The representative players must have the nationality of the country they represents.
 - However, if the participating country receives the approval of the different nationality from KBF in advance, it could be allowed.



4. Tournament Rules

- **Common Notice**
- Timers and game recorders will be used for all games.
- Electronic devices would be prohibited during the match.
- Going to the <u>bathroom with stopping the timer</u> should be allowed only one time per a game.
- *If you have unavoidable issue like disease, please contact the staff before the registration.
- Tie break: WINS > SOS > SOSOS

1) Championship of National representative players

- O Tournament: 7 round Swiss System
- O Time limit: 40 minutes + Fischer time 20 seconds increment per move
- Rule: All Even games, 6.5 points Dum(=Komi)

2) Championship of U15 Youth representative players

- Tournament: 6 round Swiss System 〈TBD〉
- O Time limit: 40 minutes + Fischer time 20 seconds increment per move
- O Rule: All Even games, 6.5 points Dum(=Komi)

3) Open Pair Baduk Tournament

- Tournament: 5 round Swiss System (TBD)
- O Time limit: 45 minutes timeout
- When there is only blank space on the board, both team can stop the timer to prevent a delayed game.
- Rule: Handicapped match, 6.5 points Dum(=Komi)
- O Pair rule
- Each pair should consist of 'man and woman' or include a 'U15 youth' player.
- A pair with same genders can also participate with a penalty.
- Please find the 'Pair Baduk guidebook' for more details.
- KPMC Special rule
 - Rule 'Random Duel' will be applied for matches without stoned.



5. Participation fee

- 1) Fee for the invited
- The Invited: Free of charge
 - 1) one national and one U15 representative player from each country
 - 2) the invited executives by Korea Baduk Federation
- 2) Participation fee for the guests
- Oguest fee: 750,000 KRW (KRW cash only)
- The guest fee should be given to the organizer at the reception desk and only KRW cash would be available.
- The guest will share the room with his/her player or executive.
- The guest fee for each group will be explained via email to tell how the total fee should be since the registration period.

7. Accommodation&meals

- Meals and accommodation shown on the schedule would be provided by the KBF.
- If you have any special dietary needs, you should write a **detailed description** (cf: No meat, but fish is available) on the registration form.

Please notice all responsibilities caused by unknown or incorrect information would lie with the people themselves.

- For vitalization of local economy, Taebaek City, <u>most dinner would</u> <u>be not provided</u>, <u>but the transfer service</u> to the main street will be provided so that participants can enjoy it free.

8. Requests

1) Visa and Invitation

- If you need a Korean Visa, <u>please check required documents with the Korean Embassy at first</u>, and let us know if there is any document that needs to be prepared by the KBF when submitting the Visa application. The official invitation would require <u>name of the invited</u>, <u>National Go Association the person belongs to, the address including his / her city, and postal (zip) code</u>. If any problem occurs by wrong information, its responsibility would be to you.

Please notice that international delivery fee should be paid by you.

2) Dress code for ceremonies

- All players are recommended **not** to wear t-shirts, jeans or similar attire during the ceremonies.

3) Anti-doping test

- Randomly selected some of the top players must accept the antidoping test when required.

4) Emergency

- When any emergency occurs, please contact the staffs.



5) No misrepresentation & Stricter identification

- Associations in each country should thoroughly <u>identify</u> the participants and <u>guarantee</u> them, who should be qualified for the representative of your country. If participants of each country cause the following troubles that result in disorder during the timeframe, KBF may hold their associations responsible for it or further invitation may be restricted or revoked.

⟨Example of trouble⟩

- (1) Doing illegal acts (violence, sex crime, theft, etc.)
- (2) Staying in Korea illegally without returning to home country
- (3) Refusing to comply with the legitimate instructions of the competition manager (cf: constant lateness for the meeting time, disobedient with the proper judgment by the referee, etc.)
- (4) Any other acts to undermine the dignity of the representative of each country significantly
